

2020 Solo Season

Are you planning to do or coach a solo, graceful or duo next year for the first time?

There is an opportunity to perform or coach a solo routine for those wishing to do something over and above team participation. Please note that to be eligible to compete in solo competitions participants must compete in all Cali-ACT team competitions. The minimum age requirement is seven years old by 31st December in the year of the competition.

The Karilee coaching team and committee feels that it is important that we are able to provide proper support to our cadets and young participants and their families in regard to solo coaching, as solos can be an incredibly useful and rewarding venture for both participant and coach.

For participants, involvement in solos helps to develop both their confidence and technical skills through one-on-one interaction with her coach, as well as improving command of the stage and providing extra incentive to continue in the sport.

For coaches, it enhances their ability to break down movements effectively and teach them correctly, ultimately creating more competent coaches.

Parents interested in finding out about solos or who are looking for a solo coach should approach the Principal coach of their daughter's age group in the first instance.

Karilee has a number of qualified Level One coaches that currently coach girls in solos. The availability and capacity of each coach is a personal matter and many coaches may not have capacity to take on additional soloist. Availability changes from year to year, so there may be opportunities that arise.

The Karilee Committee has endorsed the guidelines as a way to support the coaches, cadets and class assistants. These guidelines will help to keep participants safe and promote the development of cadets and class assistants into coaches.

If you are considering being coached by a developing coach (i.e. a cadet or class assistant), the specific requirements have been set by the Karilee coaching body and endorsed by the Committee to ensure a safe and supportive environment for what is essentially not a club-managed arrangement. **Karilee encourages you to read our club solo guidelines:** 2015-10 Karilee Solo Guidelines for Parents and/or 2015-10 Karilee Solo Guidelines for Cadets Coaches.

Next week the Cali-ACT Competition Committee will vote on **Ticket-less entry** for the Solo & Duo competitions. If the majority of the ACT Calisthenics Clubs vote in favour of Ticket-less entry, then the costs of the entries for 2020 will increase but you and family members or friends can watch the competition without requiring a ticket. Other advantages will be that we will no longer be required to provide a volunteer to man the ticket box and there are expected to be larger audiences.

Recycling



The Express drop off is designed for a small number of bags to drop off at convenient in-store locations.

It's as simple as "Bag, Drop & Go".

- Firstly place your eligible containers in durable slightly see-through bags, like the regular kitchen tidy bags you can buy from the shops.
- Drop your bags at any <u>Express location</u>; these include most Salvo or Vinnies op shops.
- Use the instore touch screen console to enter this fake mobile number **0012345678**. This number has been selected to make it easy to remember. Zero (0) will already be on the screen, **so just type in 012345678**
- Choose your refund type; **credit online account**. Karilee Calisthenics will show as the account.
- Enter the number of bags being dropped, and receive a bar-coded label for each of your bags.
- Place a label on each bag; if you have more than four bags, just repeat the process to get more labels.



- Then place your labelled bags at the collection point; staff will often assist.
- All Done. Karilee thanks you for your support; very little bit helps.

The staff at the Express location will do the rest. Your containers will be counted and properly recycled, and Karilee's account will be credited.
