Registrations for 2021

Welcome back everyone!

Over the break Karilee has implemented a new online registration management system.

We have imported most of your data into the new <u>RevolutioniseSport system</u>. You will receive an email with details to login and set your password for the online system.

Please login from the email and review your information then notify the Registrar if any updates are required.

An invoice for the Calisthenics ACT (Cali-ACT) registration fee will also be emailed to you from the online platform. This payment of \$80 is due immediately in order for you or your daughter to be registered with Calisthenics ACT.



There are also a couple of extra forms to complete, such as the medical form and declaration form. These forms are available from https://karilee.com.au/registrations/ or they can be emailed to you following your registration. Members should complete and return these forms to the Karilee Registrar as soon as possible. Next year, we plan to incorporate these extra form into the system, if possible.

At Karilee we allow you to have a variety of payment options, for those who wish to pay by regular instalments rather than per invoice. <u>Open this link to see the amount and number of payments</u> to assist you to set up regular payments with your bank.

Training for all age groups (except Seniors and Masters) will start the week commencing Feb 1, 2021 (the first week of school) so please log on and confirm your registration details as soon as possible. Karilee will run its annual Solo Competition from the 5th-8th of March at the Canberra College Performing Arts Centre. As most of you will be aware this weekend is our major fundraising event for the year, and we need your support to ensure its success. As you can imagine running a competition of this size and quality requires a huge amount of work, particularly in these strange times!

We need everyone's assistance to pitch in and make the weekend run smoothly. Each Karilee family is expected to assist with carrying out a duty over the weekend. Please set some time aside half a day over the weekend to help out in some way.

For our new families please come and help and then stay to watch for a while and see what signing up your daughter for a solo is all about! It's also a great opportunity to meet some of the other families.

Rosters will be available so you can choose a time slot that fits in with your other commitments. Please note that if you have more than one child at the Club we do expect that you fill more than one duty session. None of these duties require any previous experience just a willingness to have a go – they are all very easy. The duties will include:

- Theatre Door,
- Side stage door,
- Timers.
- · Ticket box, and
- · Canteen assistants.

We are also looking for some experienced assistance for the roles of stage manager, announcer and video operator.

We have a role for everyone so please ask if there is a role you are interested in but are unsure of and we will be pleased to provide training.

We would also normally ask each family to supply home baked goodies to be sold in the canteen, but this will depend on health restrictions in place at the time of the competition, so we'll get back to you on that one!!

Some of you may be thinking – I really don't need to help out with this, my daughter doesn't do a solo. While the competition is run for soloists - the aim is to raise additional club funds so that we don't need to increase your fees to excessive levels. In previous years, the funds have been used to subsidise each team member who travelled interstate to compete (that was Ballarat for everyone in Sub Juniors through to Seniors and the Sydney competition for the Tinies team). In 2020 these funds were used to provide the end of year Camp without the need to charge additional fees.

Please consider how you can contribute as everyone benefits.

Just to get you thinking about when you may be available the proposed competition is as follows:

- Friday evening All Duo sections
- Saturday All Sub Junior sections and possibly one Senior section
- Sunday All Intermediate sections and Seniors
- Monday All Junior sections

We ask for volunteers to choose a duty that doesn't clash with your daughter's section if the duty is not inside the theatre as the theatre doors will only be opened at the beginning, middle and end of each section.

Karilee would like to introduce our new Merchandise Officer. Thanks Amy Blyton for volunteering to take on this role in the Karilee Committee.



Remember your order is not finalised until your payment is received.


You can also arrange the return of previously owned uniforms via the new order form.

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You can also place a pre-order for the Karilee

Please, remember that we require 10 orders for the hoodies,20 orders for the Rugby Jersey and 5 orders for supporters Jackets before Karilee can place an order. It usually takes 4 to 6 weeks once the order is placed before the garments are delivered.

It is particularly important to check and order the correct size as no additional stock is ordered. If an exchange is required, Karilee will assist you to on-sell your hoodie, rugby jersey or supporters jacket.
